Answers:

1. **True** or False? One goal of Louisiana Pathways is to provide scholarships for child care employees.

One goal of Pathways is to provide scholarships for training and education in order to remove financial barriers that prevent child care employees from advancing in their education and training.

2. True or **False**? Everyone who works in child care in the state of Louisiana is required to enroll in Louisiana Pathways.

Enrollment in the Louisiana Pathways Career Development System is voluntary. However, some centers make it a requirement for employment. In addition, membership in Louisiana Pathways is a requirement for advancement in the Quality Start Child Care Rating System and receiving the School Readiness Tax Credit.

3. Which of the following information does the Registry Database include?
 - a. Demographic information
 - b. Work experience
 - c. Diplomas and transcripts
 - d. All of the above**

The Registry Database includes provider records such as demographics, current employer, work experience and educational background and achievement. The database also includes records such as certificates of training, diplomas, degrees, transcripts, credentials, and information about the member's placement on the career ladder level.

4. Which of the following would **not** be considered service to the profession?
 - a. Presenting at an early childhood conference
 - b. Serving as a CDA advisor
 - c. Serving as president of the local Kiwanis Club**
 - d. Attending an early childhood conference

While the Kiwanis Club and many other civic clubs serve an important community function and may even help with child care related issues, it is not an **early childhood** professional organization since its focus is also on other issues.
